5) If ICC CEUs are important to you - get your badge scanned when you enter the room as these sessions are ICC Approved.

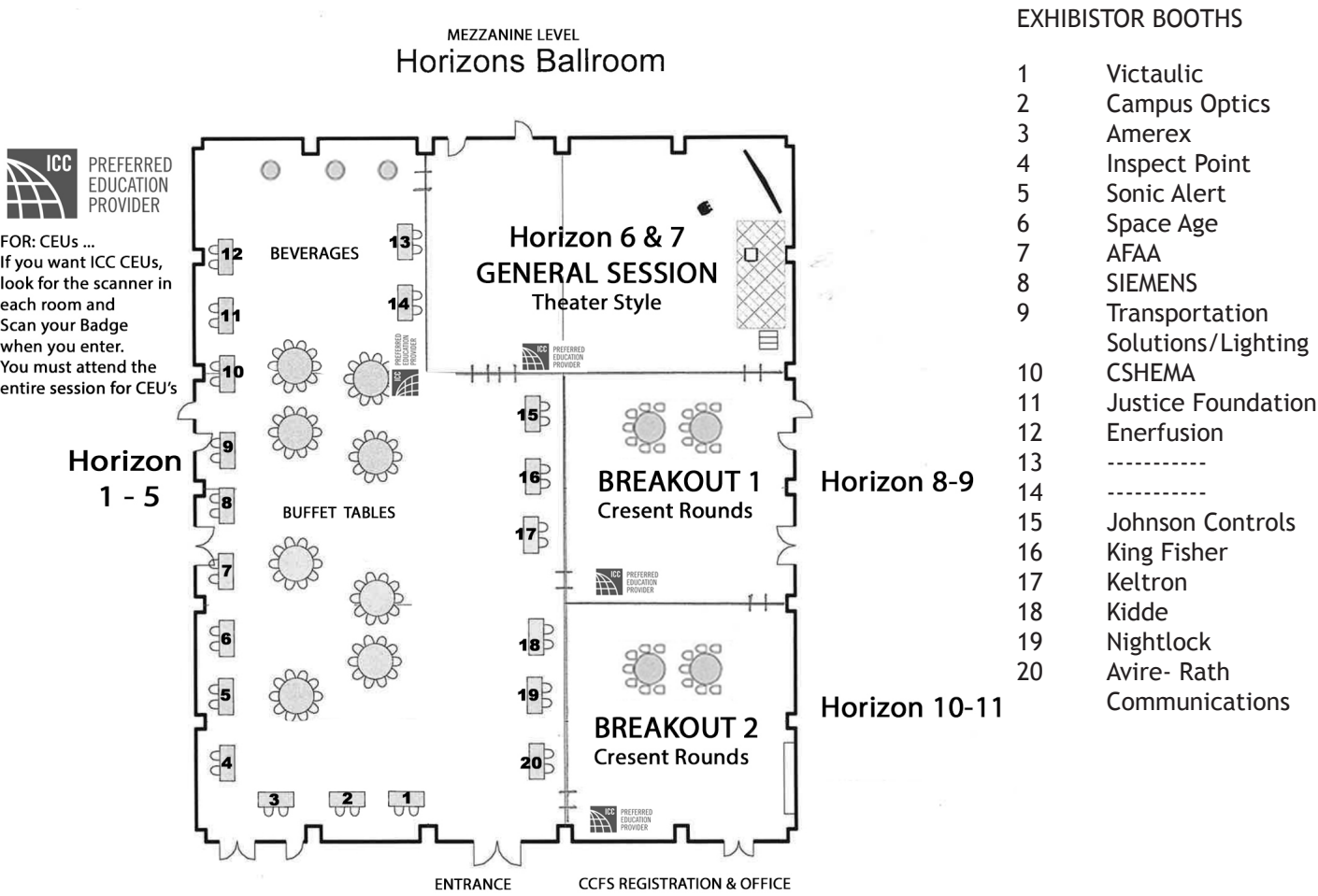
